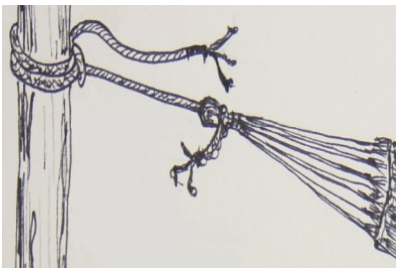
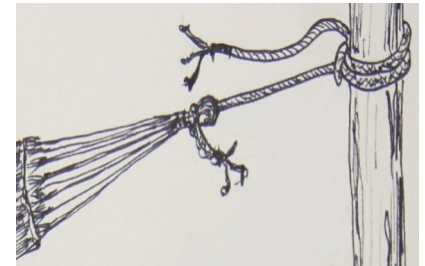


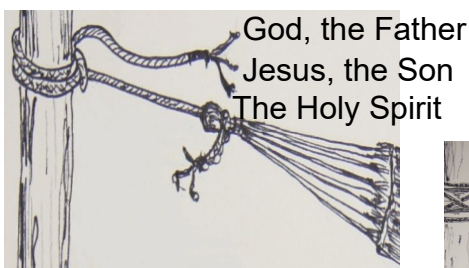
# Concept of the „Hammock of God’s Word“



On both sides the hammock is tied with a rope made of three different cords, twisted together. In the illustrations there are therefore two times three cords.



A person connected to God is: On the one side, through the three-cord rope (God, Christ and the Holy Spirit), wonderfully supported while laying down himself in "God's Word Hammock" and completely relaxed; on the other side, again by a three-cord rope (Oneself personally, the Christian Church and Mission to the world), by and for God effectively USED. This is the overall theological concept which ties in a vivid way to a hammock.



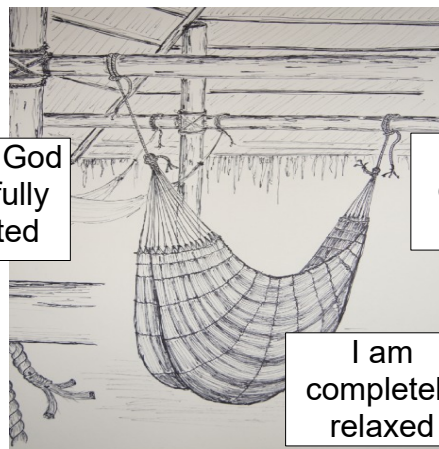
